Featured Speakers



1. **Dr. Pamela Peeke, M.D., MPH, FACP, FACSM:** Dr. Peeke is a physician, scientist, expert and thought leader in the fields of integrative and preventive medicine. She is a Pew Foundation Scholar in Nutrition and Metabolism, Assistant Professor of Medicine at the University of Maryland and a Fellow of both the American College of Physicians and the American College of Sports Medicine. Dr. Peeke is an acclaimed TED presenter, three-time New York Times bestselling author, host of the number one-rated iTunes women's health HER radio show and is the founder of the Peeke Performance Center for Healthy Living™.

2. **Charles Curie:** Mr. Curie served as Deputy Secretary for OMHSAS (1995-2001), and as SAMHSA Administrator (2001-2006). His accomplishments include work with The President's New Freedom Commission on Mental Health, the Strategic Prevention Framework for Substance Use Prevention, Access to Recovery, National Outcome Measures, and work with post-conflict and war-torn countries' MH and SU systems. Principal and Founder of The Curie Group, LLC, he currently serves on the Board of Directors of Core Solutions, Inc. and Woodley House, and Advisory Board for the Foundation for Advancing Alcohol Responsibility (FAAR).

3. **Vijay Gupta:** An accomplished violinist and advocate for the regenerative presence of artistic voices in social issues, Mr. Gupta joined the Los Angeles Philharmonic in 2007 at the age of 19, after completing his undergraduate degree in Biology and a Master's degree from the Yale School of Music. A TED speaker and Senior Fellow, he is currently completing a PhD degree in community psychology at Pacifica Graduate Institute and training in interfaith chaplaincy at LAC-USC Medical Center. He is also the founder and director of Street Symphony, a non-profit dedicated to engaging musicians in performance and dialogue with marginalized communities.

4. **Veraunda I. Jackson, Esq.:** Ms. Jackson, a Motivational Speaker and published author of three books – "Everything Has a Price", "You Don't Have to Settle!" and "Behind the Scenes" – is an outspoken and tireless advocate for abused and neglected children. A former Assistant State Attorney, she currently serves as a Senior Attorney for the Florida Department of Children and Families in Orlando. Ms. Jackson lives by the motto, "If you have the strength to survive, you have the power to succeed!"
